Fr Tristan writes: After his 'First Mass', it is a Catholic custom that a new priest offers individual 'First Blessings' to the people: and Fr Eddie will be no exception! This is a beautiful tradition will allow us all a brief, but personal moment, to greet Fr Eddie personally and wish him well in his new vocation, as well as to receive a powerful grace from the Lord.

The blessing focuses on the hands of the new priest, made holy during the Ordination with the Oil of Chrism, as hands made ready to do Christ's work; hands to bless; hands to make the Eucharist. The recipient of the blessing kneels or stands, while the new priest lays his hands on his or her head and prays. If the recipient wishes, it is customary to then kiss the priest's hands, and also to receive a little prayer card to keep in a prayer book or special place, as a promise to pray for that priest. Last week an appeal was made to all Parishioners. As a reminder, the key messages were:

- This year (2024) the Parish is expecting that it's costs will be £73,000 more than its income (The Parish Summary Accounts can be found on the Parish Website).

- It would be awful to have to contemplate cutting back on all these activities
