What we are.

Guildford Youth Ministry (GYM) is all about offering young people aged 7-18 opportunities to grow in faith and love of the Church in a fun and dynamic way. GYM is leading the way in the Diocese and the country with a full-time coordinator, a range of dynamic initiatives including weekly youth programmes and retreats.

What we offer.

GYM offers three programmes where faith teaching, discussion, expression and prayer are at the centre of the sessions. GYM provides weekly formational programmes for children in school years 3-5 (GYM-jams), school years 6-9 (jGYM) and school years 10-13 (GYM). We also have two retreats for school years 6-9 (jDAMASUS weekend away) and school years 10-13 (DAMASCUS summer camp).

What we do.

At GYM-jams and jGYM we have a cooked meal, fun activities, faith teaching, small group discussion and a time of prayer.

At GYM we have inspiring and challenging teaching and discussion about faith and life. We also have times of worship, prayer and reflection as well as lots of time to chill out and make friends.
